Volume Discounts

Volume Discounts will be offered starting on the 3rd bull purchased—3% off 3rd bull; 4% off 4th bull; and increasing 1% per additional bull purchased, up to 10% off the 10th bull.

Sale Format

Bulls will have an affordable base price that will be determined ahead of sale day. Buyer numbers will determine sale order. When we call buyer #1, they will announce what bull they would like to purchase. If other buyers are interested in the same bull, we will auction until the bull is sold. If no other buyer raises the base bid, then the bull is sold at the base price. Buyer #1 will hold the floor until he is done selecting bulls. We will do this until we have either sold out of bulls or worked through the initial list of buyers. Any bulls remaining will be available on a first come/first serve basis at the base price.
